Reentry Alliance Nebraska (RAN) is a network of people and organizations who have a shared interest in ensuring a successful transition for all Nebraskans moving from incarceration to life outside of prison.

We work toward that goal by collaborating with one another, sharing knowledge, and weighing in on problems and solutions pertaining to reentry and the justice system in Nebraska.

Our coalition includes nonprofit agencies, private businesses, faith communities, staff within the prison and probation system, people who have lived experience with Nebraska's carceral system, and other concerned community members.

RAN hosts monthly meetings to update one another on our work, discuss issues affecting those who are currently or formerly incarcerated, and learn about programs, services, and other resources that can help support reentrants.
